Conditions of membership for Sanofi-Aventis Employees and Pensioners

These conditions of membership are extracted for your information from the Club Constitution, Rules & Byelaws.
Copies are available from the Club office.

Ordinary Membership

Ordinary membership of the Club shall be open to persons employed by the Group and normally resident in the United Kingdom. Such membership shall cease immediately upon such employee ceasing to be employed or be normally resident in the United Kingdom. Ordinary membership shall be open to persons retiring from employment of the Group at a pensionable age as automatic life membership, without payment of subscription.

Associate Membership

Associate membership shall be open to employees of the group not working on the Dagenham site or residing within a 20-mile radius. They will be classed as ordinary (normal) members with no voting rights and membership rights for themselves only.

Family Membership

Family membership shall be open to parents, spouses/partners and children (under 18 years) of ordinary members but shall cease upon ordinary membership ceasing for whatever reason. Children 18 years & over may also be included in family membership but at full ordinary membership rates.

Admission to Membership

Persons may not be admitted to membership, or be admitted as candidates for membership to any privileges of membership, without an interval of 2 days between their nomination or application for membership and their admission. The Club Manager will notify all grades of membership when the election is approved, and will provide the member with a Club membership card, duly endorsed. All membership cards will be revalidated each year. The Club Manager will be responsible for ensuring that a register of all members is kept.

Subscriptions

Subscriptions shall be payable by ordinary members for themselves and all persons listed on their application form at such rates as from time to time be approved by the members in general meeting on the recommendation of the management committee as set out in byelaw 4.

Rights and obligations of members

All members of the Club shall be entitled to be present and speak at general meetings.

Ordinary members, with the exception of associate members, shall be entitled to vote at such meetings.

All Club members agree to be bound by all appropriate Club and section rules and regulations. A copy of these rules and any byelaws or regulations may be obtained from the Club Manager.

Conduct of members

If the Management Committee is satisfied that the conduct of any member is or has been detrimental to the interest of the Club it may, by a majority vote, terminate, or suspend the membership of that member, and determine the earliest date at which such persons may again apply for membership, or the period of suspension as the case may require.

The behaviour of children is the responsibility of the sponsoring member whilst on Club premises. Any complaint will be dealt with by the Disciplinary Panel and suitable action taken against the member.

Guests of members

A member may introduce a maximum of two visitors who must be *bona fide* guests and should be entertained by him/her. Such guests are not permitted to purchase intoxicating liquor and may only remain while the introducing member is present. The member is responsible for the behaviour of such visitors whilst on Club premises.
